Here are the solutions to yesterday's exercises. Please check them before you start new exercises.

1) sb. p. 59, ex. 1a+ 2

- Leo followed Sam to the boat.
- Justin filmed a scene at the gatehouse.
- Leo hid behind the gatehouse.
- Justin filmed a scene from the roof of the gatehouse.
- Sam jumped onto the deck of the old boat.
- Lucy and Maya arrived at the park.
- Lucy and Maya hid behind the gatehouse.
- Sam jumped up and fell through a hole in the boat.
- Maya swam to the boat.
- Sam and Maya swam back to the shore.

Make sure you use simple past verbs always.

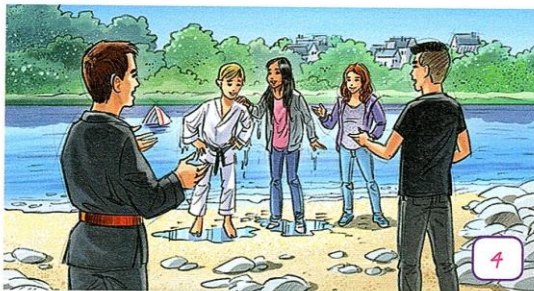
Master Wu and the magic book
