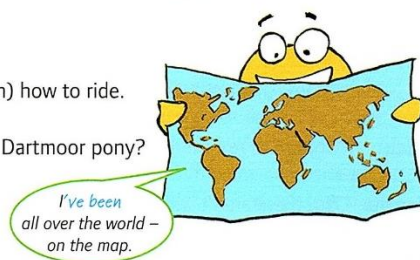

Amira: No, I didn't. I 've never learned (never, learn) how to ride.

Dan: So you 've never ridden (never, ride) a wild Dartmoor pony?

Amira: That's right. I haven't.

Dan: Lucky ponies!
