Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart is a famous classical composer who was born in Salzburg in 1756 and died in Vienna in 1791. He wrote many famous pieces and he was known as a child genius because he could play the piano and the violin extremely well at a very young age. One of his most famous operas is „The Magic Flute“.

It is important to remember people like Mozart, because he influenced the music we listen to today a lot and he is a great inspiration.
