## **Lösungshilfe**

### Introduction (topic+thesis)

The question is about New York, one of the most popular cities of the world, where circa 8 million inhabitants from all over the world spend their lives and another millions of tourists are fascinated by this city with its impressing skyscrapers, sights and multicultural atmosphere. It seems to be so attractive that many people think about moving there. But would I really want that?

### Main part (your own opinion+reasons why you think so = arguments to support your opinion)

To my mind it would be great to work and live in New York. Or: For me living in New York is not an option. (entsprechend deiner persönlichen Meinung musst du nun Argumente nachvollziehbar darlegen, die deine Meinung erklären, unterstützen)

#### arguments for living in New York:

Life in New York is never boring. People say it is the city that never sleeps. So shops, restaurants theatres, cinemas or clubs are open 7/24. You can spend your freetime with visiting amazing museums like the world-famous Modern Art Museum or in the popular theatres on the Broadway, where famous actors and actresses give interesting performances. Especially impressive are international musicals which are often performed there at first. This great cultural life is enriched by the traditions and customs, the celebrations or the food of people from all over the world, making it "the Big Apple". I think it should be quite easy to find a well-paid job in New York, if you have a good education, because many international companies have their seats there. The service sector in this city, which is open all around the clock, is a great employer, so that you can afford the life there and enjoy it very much. Etc. ...

#### arguments against living in New York:

New York is a mega city with all the problems, such cities face. Millions of people drive millions of cars, which cause overcrowded streets, traffic jams and the worst air pollution by emissions produced by these cars. People also produce a lot of waste the city has to fight with. Many people live in run-down poor areas with a high crime rate, especially drug-related crime, because they cannot afford the high rents and prices for flats and houses. The chances for kids to escape this

vicious circle are not very big. Many people work in jobs which are badly paid, but life in New York is very expensive. So they cannot enjoy the cultural life and its opportunities, because they simply cannot pay it. Therefore life in New York is not very attractive for me. Etc. ...
